Some species (such as raptors, bats and songbirds) are routinely transferred to CWC or CRC. There is no way to know the dispositions of animals transferred out. They are counted only in our total. Animals transferred to a facility for long term placement are counted as a release for our statistics. Individuals, families, and Healthpointe Veterinary Clinic are counted as single members for reporting data.
